Terms of Reference for Mentees

Aim of the Masterclass

To develop professional behaviour and long-term educational skill sets in Hematology. This is in order to enhance professional practice and mobility.

The main responsibilities will be to

- Meet with mentor and fellow mentees at EHA Congresses
- Participate in 5 case-studies over an 8 month-period
- Engage with fellow mentees in web-based problem solving
- Take part in meetings to acquire skills in e-learning tools
- Contribute to Masterclass evaluation to shape its future development

Criteria of selection

- Within last 12 months to completion of specialist training in Hematology (at time of EHA Congress Masterclass launch)
- Good written communicative skills in Masterclass language (English)
- Expected to devote 4-6 hours per week during the case study period
- Willingness to participate in online discussions and feedback sessions
- Evidence of using EHA CV Passport in self-evaluation of knowledge base

- Special invites to EHA Congresses during Masterclass involvement with free registration and unique identifiers
- Acknowledgement on EHA web and relevant communications
- Excellent contributions will be formally recognised at year end
- Access to international leaders in Hematology field
- Support by national society via its EHA linker

Groups & Subjects

- Each group consists of one mentor and 6 mentees
- Case studies will be based on EHA CV Passport: Clinical Hematology, Diagnostics, Thrombosis & Haemostasis, Transfusion Medicine.

Reporting Arrangements

- Group learning activities and summations will be posted at end of each study period to be shared with other groups
- Case authors will feedback at end of case study and highlight notable contributions
